This summer's Innovation Festival will be a first of its kind for the highways sector.

The new event will bring together local authorities, central government, the supply chain, associations and academia. Topics covered at the festival will include: maintenance, technology, resilience, winter, sustainability, carbon reduction, procurement, market intelligence and trends.

The event will be held at Newark Showground, with indoor and outdoor exhibitions, as well as product demonstrations on a test road environment.

Delegates will be taken on an innovation journey, discovering the latest innovations that the highways sector has to offer and will hear from innovators and front line staff who are driving forward with new ideas to help deliver change in the sector.

LCRIG is inviting organisations to attend and exhibit at the Innovation Festival with a contribution from all exhibitors being put towards the LCRIG 'Steve Berry - Think Exceptional' Innovation Fund.

A number of councils have also committed to making their road networks available for trials along with funding for qualifying innovators who participate in the Festival.


Private sector delegates are also invited to attend the event free of charge.


